Entries (for dressage classes) close October 15th

Class Descriptions Show starts at 9 am

1. Costume Class – dress yourself AND your horse up.

2. Showmanship In-hand

Ponies/horses to wear a bridle. Handlers to be judged on correct aids for showing at walk and jog, turning and presenting the horse in a balanced halt for the judge. Marks given for cleanliness and neatness of animal, tack and handler. Pattern will be posted

3. Dressage Intro Level

State test to be ridden on entry form (Entries must be in by Sun. Oct 15th for times to be assigned)

4. Dressage Training Level

State test to be ridden on entry form (*Entries must be in by Sun. Oct 15th for times to be assigned*)

5. Dressage First Level

State test to be ridden on entry form (Entries must be in by Sun. Oct 15th for times to be assigned)

6. Test of Choice – 2nd and above

Second level and above. Please state on entry form your test of choice. Classes will be divided as entries allow. (Entries must be in by Sun. Oct 15th for times to be assigned)

7. Leadline

Riders will be judged on equitation in walk and some trot. Leaders must be parents, other family members or other qualified persons



Rookie Division –walk/trot

- **8. Equitation-**Riders will be judged on their position, control of horse and use of aids. Diagonals not to count
- **9. Pleasure-** Judged on horse's willingness, steadiness of gaits and transitions
- **10. Tiny trail-** Trot cones, one pole to go over and two to go through

Walk/Trot Division

- **11. Equitation** Riders will be judged on their position, control of the horse and use of aids.
- **12. Pleasure** Judged on horse's willingness, steadiness of gaits and transitions
- **13. Ground Poles** Ability to ride accurate lines in a good rhythm over a course of poles at trot.

Walk-Trot-Canter Division

- **14. Equitation** Riders will be judged on their position, control of the horse and use of aids.
- **15. Fences 18"** 8 crossrails, no change of direction course will be posted
- **16. Fences 2'** 8 fences, one change of direction course will be posted

Just Jumping

- 17. "Blox" elimination jump a line of "blox" laid out. One refusal or knock down out. One "blox" will be removed and the line will be jumped again until only a single "blox" remains
- **18. Fences 2'3"** A course of 10-12 jumps
- **19. Fences 2'6" –** A course of 10-12 jumps
- **20. Games** may be divided into skill levels if entries warrant

- **21. Leadline Trail** to be led over and around obstacles
- **22. Gamblers choice trail** Varied trail obstacles, all with assigned point values. Timed course. Highest point wins.
